Besides the many trips to Peru this year including the month of July. I also ministered in Colombia and in churches around the states speaking about missions. I am excited about 2005 and the opportunities that lie ahead. I will be going back to Peru in February, in the summer and again in the fall, Lord willing. We don't have a missionary in Lima or Tarma at this time, so I am working directly with the pastors with the aid of Hector Del Carpio a Peruvian missionary and brother. I also have trips planned to Colombia and possibly Bolivia and Africa. Megan will be going to Africa in May with a group from her college.

**The pictures to the left are of our Cross Street Youth Mission Team in Lima and Tarma, Peru.** This team is always such a joy and blessing to me and to the people in Peru. We ministered in schools, on the streets, in churches etc. We saw many come to know the Lord in the two weeks they were in Peru.

**I've also included some pictures of the new church/feeding center built this summer in Patacutec with Spirit and Truth Church of Tavernier, Florida.** Spirit & Truth donated the money to buy the property last year and this year with a team of 21 joined us in Lima, Peru to construct this building. It is always amazing to see God fulfill His plan. I'm discovering more and more all we need to do is say "Here I am Lord, Send me" and He will. He opens doors no man can shut and shuts doors no man can open. We are also thankful for the Rotary Club of the Upper Keys for their financial help in this project. Also, to our Peruvian brother Hector who was such a blessing in helping to make this project happen.

**The Spirit & Truth team was such a blessing to the poor people of this sandy slum found on the outskirts of Lima.** The team ranged from 14 to 70 years of age and worked together wonderfully to get the job done. Besides constructing, the team also ministered to the children daily and at a school plus did women's ministry and two church services. All in between getting this 25 by 50 foot building raised. One of the greatest blessings to me was watching Pastor Fabian while the construction was going on. He worked side by side with us each day. To see this humble Peruvian pastor's prayers answered is such a blessing to me. They've labored for years without much help at all and then God opened up the doors of provision. Their dream, their heart, their vision is to minister to the poor. The amazing thing is, they too are poor! You would never know it to see the smiles on their faces and the passion in their hearts and lives. One reason, I've been so dedicated to helping Fabian is because he never really came asking for much, except to help bring the word of God to the people there.

**The church now meets three times a week and there is also a Feeding Center in operation.** The children are fed four times a week. They were already feeding the children one day a week on their own and now Spirit and Truth Church is supporting this feeding center where 60 to 80 children are fed three more days a week. On my last visit there in September, Pastor Fabian and Cecilia were showing us the discipleship materials they are using for the children as they come to eat. God is so good!
